施設紹介	「戦国の庭 歴史館」は別名、「吉川元春館跡 展示室」です。吉川元春は、「三矢の訓」で有名な戦国大名 毛利元就の次男で、当時この地域を治めていた武将です。吉川元春館跡は、1583年頃元春が隠居する住まいとして建てた館の遺跡で、その発掘調査や文献調査から中世の人々の暮らしが明らかになりました。展示室は6つのステージに別れています。順番に見て中世の遺跡と暮らしを学びましょう。
Facility introduction	“Sengoku no niwa rekishi-kan” is also known as an “exhibition room of the remains of Motoharu Kikkawa Residence” Motoharu Kikkawa was the second son of Motonari Mori, who was well-known for his “three arrow teachings”. Motoharu was a warrior, who ruled this area at that time. This is a remain of his house built about 1583 to spend the retirement life. The excavation and documentary record of the remains of this building has helped reveal the lifestyle of people in the medieval period. The exhibition room is divided into six sections. By looking at them in order, you can learn about the historical remains and lifestyle of medieval period.
