しせつしょうかい 施設紹介	「天才棋士本因坊秀策」は、江戸時代末期に尾道市因島で生まれ育ちました。秀策は、二十歳で第十四世本因坊跡目を襲名。そして「御城碁」では空前絶後の十九連勝という偉業を成し遂げました。囲碁記念館には、「天才棋士本因坊秀策」の遺品や、尾道市市技囲碁に関する資料を収集、保管及び展示しています。また、生家は、現存する旧生家家相図を元に再現しています。
Facility introduction	Go Master Shusaku Honinbo was born and raised in Innoshima, Onomichi City at the end of the Edo era (the mid-19th century). At the age of 20, Shusaku became the 14th successor of the Honinbo school (the most important institute of the game of Go in Japan). He earned a perfect score with 19 straight wins in the Go castle games. Our hall collects, stores and displays Go Master Shusaku Honinbo's memorabilia and extensive materials of the game of Go, which has been adopted as our city game. In addition, we have reconstructed the house where Shusaku was born to its original architectural design.

Transportation	By Car: From Honshu Take the Shimanami Expressway and exit at the "Innoshima Kita (North) I.C.". From there, it is about 5 minutes by car. ※Free Parking Lot: For 10 cars By Bus: From "Habuko (Habu Port)" Bus Stop, take the Innoshima bus bound for Innoshima O-hashi, and get off at "Irikawabashi". It takes approximately 20 minutes by bus. From Irikawabashi stop to Go Memorial Hall, it takes about 10 minutes on foot.
