

【To people whose homes and yards were flooded】

If your house was flooded by muddy water due to the heavy rain, please make sure to wash and then disinfect the area after it has dried. Disinfectant is not very effective if the area is dirty. Make sure to also thoroughly wash the outer walls and trees in your yard.

① Clean the floor surfaces

(1)After the water is gone, get rid of any wet tatami and other items you do not need in your house.

(2)Wash any dirty furniture, floors and walls with water, then wipe them with a damp cloth and dry them.

(3)As for plates, cutlery and cooking utensils, please wash them thoroughly with water to clean them.

(4)Please dry them well after wiping them with a cloth that has been soaked with disinfectant and diluted with water,

② Clean around the house and under the floors

After removing any mud and sand, wash with water and dry thoroughly. If any mud, sand, or water remains under the floor, the condition of the house may worsen later on.

(1)Clean up by getting rid of any mud and garbage.

(2)Please thoroughly wash any mud off the trees in your yard and walls of your house.

(3)Please remove any garbage from the air vent beneath the floor to ensure that wind can properly pass through it.

(4)After removing mud from under the floor, wipe with a cloth to make sure there is no water remaining and then thoroughly dry the area with a fan, etc.

③ Disinfect

When using a disinfectant, read the instructions well and pay attention to avoid causing any accidents. (Avoid putting it in anything that could be used for drinking

so that no one accidentally drinks it. Please make sure to use all of it so that nothing remains in the container.)

(1) Places to disinfect

Inside the house (walls, floors, closets and anything else that was immersed in dirty water)

(2) How to make (example)

Add enough water to 10ml of 10% benzalkonium chloride so that it comes to 2 liters total.

(3) How to use

Wash mud and other dirt with water or wipe it well with a cloth. After thoroughly drying, wipe well with a cloth soaked with disinfectant and diluted with water. (If using a spray, just wet the area. After this, allow the wind to pass through and dry it.) The disinfectant is not very effective when used on areas that are dirty or wet.

* When using disinfectant, put on rubber gloves and make sure it does not come into contact with your body or eyes. If it comes into contact with your body, wash well with water and soap. If it comes into contact with your eyes, wash your eyes with water for at least 15 min. and then go see a doctor.

* After use, please thoroughly wash the bucket that contained disinfectant with water.
